Biography <p>Paul trained in clinical medicine in Cambridge and Oxford and specialised in Infectious diseases. After a PhD studying HIV with Andrew McMichael and Rodney Phillips in Oxford, and a postdoc in Zurich studying LCMV with Rolf Zinkernagel and Hans Hengartner, he returned to Oxford and set up studies on persistent virus infection in the Department of Medicine. The main focus of these has been viral hepatitis and studies in the liver led to CD161 expression and then to MAIT cells. Paul's lab is interested in how these cells (and related populations) are activated, their functions, and their roles in different clinical settings - including viral infections, vaccines and host defence in the gut and liver. The research has been mainly funded by the Wellcome Trust and translational studies also through the National Institute of Health Research.</p>
